**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FUND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN
AGREEMENT WITH ARMANDO RICCIO, ESQUIRE, FOR THE PREPARATION AND
PRESENTATION OF ANTI HARASSMENT TRAINING TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITY
MANAGERS & SUPERVISORS**

WHEREAS, the Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland Counties Municipal Joint Insurance Fund has been organized pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:10-36 et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland Counties Municipal Joint Insurance Fund is duly constituted as a Municipal Self Insurance Fund to provide insurance coverage to its member municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the FUND is a member of the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund (NJ MEL); and

WHEREAS, as a member of the NJ MEL, the FUND members participate in the NJ MEL's Employment Practices and Public Officials Risk Management Program; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of this program is the training of FUND members' managers and supervisors in the areas of harassment, laws against discrimination, and the Conscientious Employee Protection Act (CEPA); and

WHEREAS, Armando Riccio is an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Armando Riccio has many years of experience in employment related law and has undertaken training on the FUND's behalf in the past; and


WHEREAS, the total cost of this training is \$1,400;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland Counties Municipal Joint Insurance Fund that the Fund Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Armando Riccio for the preparation and presentation of managerial and supervisory training at a cost not to exceed \$1,400.

This Resolution was duly adopted by the Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland Counties Municipal Joint Insurance Fund at a public meeting held on February 26, 2018.
